The covenant will also prohibit any future subdividing unless certain conditions are met. In Diamond Valley, any future use of the land must be in accordance with the Groundwater Management Plan.

Submission of this application does not bind the Seller or CNRWA. If the CNRWA approves this application, the purchase will be contingent upon a showing of marketable title for the groundwater right(s) to the satisfaction of the CNRWA in its sole discretion, execution of a binding purchase and sale agreement, a restrictive covenant, a grant bargain and sale deed, any forms required by the Nevada Division of Water Resources, and such additional documents that may be required to effectuate the purchase.
